The Vineyard

We planted two acres of a special clonal selection of Aglianico from Italy's famous Rauscedo nursery in 2003. The vines were spaced 3 feet apart and trained as vertical shoot positioned monocordons to maximize fruit intensity.

Winemaker Notes

With our ability to bring reds to full maturation in Amador County, this 2010 Aglianico has a vibrant color and shows impressive concentration. It has mint, raspberry and rhubarb aromas. Complex berry flavors are framed by a firm tannin structure.
