The Vineyard

A special section of 40-year-old head-pruned vines from Frank Alviso's Clockspring Vineyard provided the fruit for this classic Amador County Zinfandel. Clockspring Vineyard is a 350 acre certified organic vineyard.

Winemaker Notes

Lush cherry and spicy aromas lead to rich cherry and raspberry fruit flavors accented with black pepper. Well-balanced, with ripe tannins and a lingering finish the wine can be enjoyed by itself or with food.
